Kindergarten

- Sense of Christian community amongst classroom and entire school
- High emphasis on parent/teacher communication
- Quarterly progress reports

Bible Study

- Based on Concordia Publishing House One In Christ
- Provide an overview of both Old Testament and New Testament
- Apply God's Word to daily life
- Learn weekly verses that enhances
 Bible lessons
- Worship weekly in a whole school chapel

Language Arts Literacy

- Study each letter and sound extensively
- Participate in shared and guided reading and writing activities

- Assess individual learning frequently
- Engage in literature experiences daily with manipulatives and literature
- Visit the school library weekly
- Learn in a variety of formats, such as centers focused for small groups, partners, whole group, and individuals
- Practice beginning reading skills using consonant and short vowel letter sounds

Mathematics

- Subject matter supported in a Spiral curriculum
- Introduce Calendar and small group activities
- Reinforce concepts with manipulatives
- Provide hands-on activities to help master numbers, counting patterning, sorting, money, measurement, and time

Science

- Learn scientific concepts through real experiences
- While studying the Life and Physical Sciences, students observe, communicate, classify, measure, and predict to support topics being taught
- Field Trips enhance Science concepts

Social Studies

Computers
